

## Privacy Policy

Alliance for Community Peace (ACP), a not-for-profit organization located at 2925 South Wabash Ave., Suite 104, Chicago, Illinois 60616, is committed to protecting the privacy and confidentiality of the youth, families, elders, clients, staff, volunteers, partners, and funders we serve. This Privacy Policy explains how ACP collects, uses, stores, and safeguards information.

ACP may collect various types of information, including personal information such as names, contact information, demographic details, emergency contacts, and other information voluntarily provided by clients, youth participants, families, and funders. It also collects program information like participation records, service history, assessments, and outcomes related to ACP programs. Donor and funder information includes contact details, donation history, grant information, and communication preferences. Operational information covers staff and volunteer records necessary for employment, compliance, and safety. Additionally, technical information such as basic website analytics, including IP address, browser type, and pages visited, may be collected.

ACP uses collected information to provide youth, family, elder, and community services, maintain safety, accountability, and program quality, communicate with clients, partners, and funders, meet reporting requirements for grants, contracts, and compliance, improve programs, operations, and community impact, and process donations while maintaining donor records.

ACP does not sell or trade personal information. Information may be shared only when required by law, court order, or mandated reporting obligations, necessary to protect the safety of youth, families, elders, or staff, required by funders or government agencies for compliance, monitoring, or reporting, or authorized in writing by the individual or their legal guardian.

ACP uses reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect information from unauthorized access, disclosure, or misuse. Only authorized personnel and partners with a legitimate need have access to sensitive information.

ACP takes special care to protect the privacy of youth, elders, and other vulnerable individuals. Information about minors is collected only with appropriate consent and used solely for programmatic and safety purposes.

ACP respects the privacy of all donors and funders. Donation information is used only for processing contributions, acknowledging support, and meeting reporting requirements. Individuals may request to review or update their personal information, ask how their information is being used, and request corrections to inaccurate information. Requests can be made by contacting ACP directly.

ACP may update this Privacy Policy to reflect changes in laws, regulations, or organizational practices. Updated versions will be made available upon request.
